Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Mason in the District Council of Pamplemousses.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in the scale of Rs 13010 x 260 – 14050 x 275 – 15150 x 300 – 15750 x 325 – 17700 x 375 – 19575 x 475 – 21950 x 625 – 23200 x 775 - 23975 a month.

Appointment to the grade in a temporary capacity carries salary at the flat rate of Rs 13010 a month.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should have reached their $\underline{18}^{th}$ birthday and unless already in the Local Government Service/Public Service/ Approved Service, should not have reached their $\underline{48}^{th}$ birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

By selection from among candidates reckoning at least two years' experience in masonry and who hold:-

(i) the Certificate of Primary Education; and

(ii) the National Trade Certificate (Level 3) awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD) in Masonry.

(iii) the trade test certificate in Masonry.

An equivalent qualification to (i), (ii) & (iii) above acceptable to the Local Government Service Commission.

- **NOTE 1:** Candidates should show proof of all experience claimed.
- NOTE 2: The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience claimed and equivalence of qualification and recognition of institution (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of experience claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, <u>by the</u> <u>closing date</u>.

- 4. To dress stone (basalt) or brick for any purpose.
- 5. To build any of the various course stone walls in correct bond.
- 6. To build walls with "libages" and know the correct use of the "parpaings".
- 7. To point joints in stone walls.
- 8. To build walls, drains and other accurate structure.
- 9. To carry out rendering works in general.
- 10. Must fully understand the mixing of mortar and concrete and be able to place concrete for all concrete structures and buildings.
- 11. To work from dimensional sketches and drawings.

- 12. To ensure good safety conditions while on duty.
- 13. Other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to them according to their postings.
