II. AGE LIMIT:

Candidates should have reached their <u>18th</u> birthday and unless already in the Local Government Service/Public Service/Approved Service, should not have reached their <u>40th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS:
