#### III. **QUALIFICATIONS**:

By selection from candidates residing within the boundaries of the District Council of Black River and who:

- (i) have obtained passes in at least 3 subjects at School Certificate level; and
- (ii) possess a Certificate in Sewing and Embroidery from a recognised institution

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Equivalent qualifications acceptable to the Local Government Service Commission

#### **NOTE**

- 1. The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 2. Candidates should enclose photocopies of their National Identity Card, academic/technical qualifications and where applicable, equivalence of qualification and relevant documentary evidence of experience claimed.

- 3. Candidates may be requested to submit a Certificate of Character.
- 4. Candidates are informed that they may be outposted to any Sub Office of the Local Authority, and also, with the approval of the appropriate authority, to any other Local Authority where their services will be required.

#### IV. DUTIES:

- 1. To run classes in sewing, embroidery and sometimes handicrafts at the Village Hall within prescribed time by the Council.
- 2. To maintain discipline and order among pupils attending the sewing classes.
- 3. To keep attendance register of all pupils, report poor attendance and enquire thereon.
- 4. To make quarterly assessments on progress of work.
- 5. To conduct examinations both theoretical and practical in collaboration with the Supervisor, Sewing Classes at the end of the course.
- 6. To be responsible for the registration of pupils.
- 7. To sew buntings, flags, curtains etc. for the Council.
- 8. To keep all tools and equipment concerning the sewing.
- 9. To perform such other cognate duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to them according to their posting.
