VACANCY FOR THE POST OF MECHANIC LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Mechanic in the Local Authorities.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in the scale of Rs 15745 x 260 – 17825 x 275 – 18925 x 300 – 19525 x 325 – 21475 x 375 – 22225 x 400 – 23425 x 525 – 26050 x 675 – 27400 x 825 – 28225 a month.

Appointment to the grade in a temporary capacity carries salary at the flat rate of Rs 15,745 a month.

2. <u>AGE LIMIT</u>

Candidates should have reached their <u>18th</u> birthday and unless already in the Local Government Service/Public Service/Approved Service should not have reached their <u>48th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

3. **QUALIFICATIONS**

By selection from among candidates who reckon at least two years' experience in Petrol and Diesel Mechanics and who hold: -

(i) the Certificate of Primary Education (A photocopy of the Certificate of Primary Education should be submitted along with application form); and

(ii) the National Trade Certificate (Level 3) awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD) in Petrol and Diesel Mechanics.

(iii) the trade test certificate in Petrol and Diesel Mechanics.

An equivalent qualification to (i), (ii) & (iii) above acceptable to the Local Government Service Commission.

Note: Candidates should show proof of all experience claimed.

<u>NOTE:</u>

- 1: The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience/ knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification and recognition of institution (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of nonsubmission of written evidence of experience/ knowledge claimed and an Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 2: Candidates should enclose photocopies of their National Identity Card and academic/technical qualifications.
- *3: Candidates may be required to submit a Character Certificate.*
- 4: Candidates are informed that they may be outposted to any sub-office of the Local Authority, and also, with the approval of the appropriate authority, to any other Local Authority where their services will be required.

4. <u>DUTIES</u>

- 1. To carry out the necessary measurements and calculations of the trade.
- 2. To use and keep in good condition the tools in general use in the trade.
- 3. To produce simple parts involving fitting work and soldering.
- 4. To strip completely, overhaul and re-assemble any mechanical assembly of mechanical vehicles, hydraulic/pneumatic assembly of vehicles and equipment, hydraulic/pneumatic brakes, control valves, compactors, including valve grinding, fitting pistons and rings in all types of engines.
- 5. To carry out bench testing of hydraulic/pneumatic parts using appropriate gauges.
- 6. To carry out minor adjustments to a motor vehicle, such as brakes, clutch etc. and be able to locate and repair minor troubles.
- 7. To ensure proper servicing and repair of vehicles and other machines and equipment including gardening equipment viz brush cutters, lawn mowers, chainsaws, etc.
- 8. To keep the environment and working area in good and tidy condition to ensure good safety condition while on duty.
- 9. To carry out the necessary checks, verifications of vehicles and prepare list of required spare parts.
- 10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to them according to their postings.
