Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Panel Beater in the Local Government Service.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in the scale of Rs $15745 \times 260 - 17825 \times 275 - 18925 \times 300 - 19525 \times 325 - 21475 \times 375 - 22225 \times 400 - 23425 \times 525 - 26050 \times 675 - 27400 \times 825 - 28225$ a month.

Appointment to the grade in a temporary capacity carries salary at the flat rate of Rs 15745 a month.

II. AGE LIMIT:

Candidates should have reached their <u>18th</u> birthday and unless already in the Local Government Service/Public Service/Approved Service should not have reached their <u>48th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS:

By selection among candidates reckoning at least two years' experience in the trade and who hold:

(i) the Certificate of Primary Education; and

(ii) the National Trade Certificate (Level 3) awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD) in the appropriate trade

(iii) the trade test certificate in the appropriate trade.

An equivalent qualification to (i), (ii) & (iii) above, acceptable to the Local Government Service Commission.

Candidates should show proof of all experience claimed.

The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. - 2. Candidates should enclose photocopies of their National Identity Card and Academic/Technical qualifications.

IV. <u>DUTIES</u>

- 1. To carry out the necessary measurements and calculations of the trade.
- 2. To use and keep in good condition the tools in general use in the trade.
- 3. To use efficiently all marking and measuring instruments used in the trade, i.e. gauges, calipers, and compasses etc.
- 4. To be very proficient in oxy-acetylenes plus electric arc welding and must be able to perform all types of welding operations on thin mind steel plates including butt, fillet and vertical welding.
- 5. To also remove and replace all weathered iron sheets and chassis of vehicles.
- 6. To be thoroughly acquainted with the use of types of oxy-acetylenes flames, fluxes and filter wads.
- 7. To shape metal by hand to any shape required in the course of normal body repairing operations.
- 8. To perform oxy-acetylenes plus electric arc cutting of metals.
- 9. To repair corroded body sections and component body paints of vehicles damaged in accident.
- 10. To check and correct for misalignment on separate chassis and monoconstructed bodies.
- 11. To estimate the materials and labour required for any panel beating job.
- 12. To ensure good safety conditions while on duty.
- 13. Other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to them according to their postings.
